Our dental insurance is set to expire at the end of December. Our current Insurance broker, Kapnick, secured the renewal rates listed below for Delta Dental in 2022.

The 7.55% increase to the plan is not insignificant, however, the cost can be managed by the current benefit budget line allocation. Additionally, dental insurance does not count toward the library's limits on insurance payments for public employees under PA 152. Therefore, I recommend renewing our current plan with Delta Dental and requiring no additional employee contributions to these premiums.



In order to ensure that staff are not coming to work when they have symptoms, I recommend renewing the library's two weeks of Emergency Leave (EL). I recommend renewing a full two weeks for all full-time staff and pro-rated time for part-time and temporary staff, throughout the entire 2022 fiscal year. EL is set to expire on December 31, 2021. It has been an invaluable resource in preventing workplace exposure and encouraging employee adherence to our mitigation policies.
