

There are typically up to three Board members on each committee, as more than three constitutes a quorum of the Board and meetings must operate as Board meetings. Be ready to indicate your interest in joining a committee or moving to a new assignment.

The Library Board elects three trustees to serve on the 5 member VEBA Board, which oversees the Trust fund to provide retiree medical benefits. These trustees serve indefinite terms 'at the pleasure of the Board, but only so long as they remain members of the Library Board. Current Board Trustees are Morrison and Pappas. Other members of the Board are myself, and employee representative, Alice McCardell. Finally, it is customary to assign Trustees to weekly check-signing duties (typically Friday afternoon – Monday evening). All Trustees except the Treasurer take responsibility for a four-month period. Two signers are assigned to each period. Trades are arranged individually to cover vacations. Note that Trustees Morrison and Walsh are committed to signing in January, 2023, prior to final determination of the schedule. Current check signers are:

RE: Board By-Law Legal Review, First Reading

The library is currently pursuing 501c3 status, and as a result, there are some additions we need to make to our board by-laws to make it compliant with IRS stipulations.

The first change required is to clarify the purpose of the organization through an addition to the first paragraph. The second change required is to demonstrate that there is a process in place for dissolution in the event that the library ceases to exist. Rules for this are already governed by state law.

In addition to the two updates above, we are having our legal team review the document for any additional suggested updates.

A current copy of our by-laws was attached to the memo for item #2 on our agenda. A draft copy of the recommended updates from our attorneys will be available at the meeting. I suggest we plan to approve the updates at the February board meeting.
