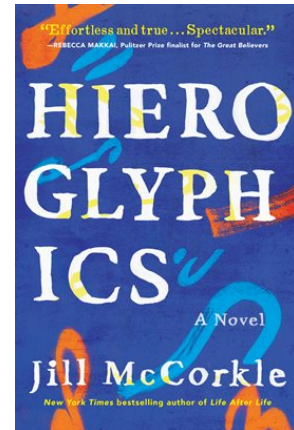


# E-BOOK CLUB KITS
