For those interested in adding intricate designs to their projects, our Brother Pacesetter ULT2003D embroidery machine is at your service. It comes loaded with 163 Disney designs, 71 embroidery patterns, and 11 adjustable monogram fonts. If you want to experiment with your own designs, our PED-Basic card readers in the Lab can easily transfer .PES and .PEN files that you've created. Additionally, our lab computers are equipped with Ink/Stitch, which allows you to design your own files. Don't worry if you don't have your own designs - you can also purchase or obtain them from the internet.

While we provide a limited selection of standard needle sizes, scrap fabric, and thread, we recommend that you bring any specific materials required for your project. This ensures that you have everything you need to bring your creative vision to life.
