PUBLIC COMMENT

- 1. The Public will be given the opportunity to speak at regular Plymouth District Library Board meetings under the agenda item 'Public Comment' on topics relating to Library business or issues.
- 2. If a person has comments concerning an agenda item, s/he will be asked to hold his/her comments until that item is considered. Chair will recognize public comments during discussion of agenda items, after Trustees are given ample opportunity to discuss the item and prior to a vote being taken.
- 3. Chair will ask speakers to give their names and address.
- 4. Comments will be limited to five (5) minutes. A person will not be allowed to speak again on the same issue until everyone else who wishes to comment has done so. Chair has the discretion to limit the number of times upon which an individual can address the Board on the same issue. If a citizen thinks his/her comments will require more than ten minutes, s/he should contact the Library Director in person and ask to be placed on the agenda so the meeting can be conducted in an orderly and timely fashion.

These rules will be posted in the Library and in the meeting place during scheduled meetings.
