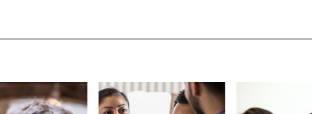

Upcoming Opportunities to Donate and Share

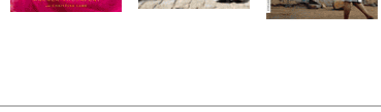
Looking to give back to your local community and clean out your closet? Check out these upcoming opportunities:
