ACTION HATS

Find a baseball cap to wear and act out what a baseball player does.

Find a cowboy hat and pretend to ride a horse.

Find a baby's hat and pretend to be a baby.

ART!

Can you make a collage out of materials you have at home? Use scraps of paper, beads, feathers, sequins, beans, and glue them on a piece of paper. What else can you think of to use?

Make a drawing or painting of yourself in a fantastic hat. What character will you decide to be? Pick your favorite style.

Did you notice that Mr. Bear's house changed in some of the pictures, turning into a castle when the dragon is there? Imagine what your house could look like if different people, animals, or things came to visit. Make a drawing or painting from your imagination.

DANCING

Put on some music and have your child pick a hat to wear.

Have child dance to the music with the hat on.

HAT PARADE

If you have friends to play with, have them each choose a hat and make up your own small hat parade.

If there is just you plan a parade with your stuffed animals, where everyone is wearing a hat.
