Action Rhyme:

Pat-a-Cake

Song/Actions:

Rock-a-bye Baby(rock back and forth) On the treetop (lift baby up high) When the wind blows (blow) The cradle will rock (rock baby) When the bough breaks(bend forward) The cradle will fall (bend back) And down will come baby (lift baby up & back into lap) Cradle and All.

Action Rhyme:

Ball for Baby

Here's a Ball for Baby, Big and soft and round. (touch fingertips together to make a ball) Here's the baby's hammer, Oh, see how he can pound (pound one fist on the other) Here is the baby's music clapping, clapping so (clap hands) Here are the baby's soldiers standing in a row (hold up hands with ten fingers) Here is baby's trumpet, toot, toot, toot! (hold one fist over the other in front of mouth)

Here's the way that baby plays at peek-a-boo (cover eyes with fingers)

Fingler Play:

Two Little Eyes

Two little eyes to look around, (tap near baby's eyes) Two little ears to hear each sound, (tap baby's ears) One little nose to smell what's sweet, (tap baby's nose) One little mouth that likes to eat. (tap baby's mouth) Two little hands go clap, clap, clap! (clap) Two little feet go tap, tap, tap! (tap feet together)

Closing song:

<u>Roly Poly</u>

Roly poly, roly poly, in and out, in and out, (roll baby on lap) Roly roly poly, roly roly poly, in and out, in and out. (lean forward & back) Roly poly, roly poly, nose and toes, nose and toes, (touch baby's nose and toes) Roly roly poly, roly roly poly, nose and toes, nose and toes.

Baby's Fingers

These are Baby's fingers, (point to baby's fingers) These are Baby's toes, (point to baby's toes) This is baby's belly, (point to baby's belly) 'round and 'round it goes. (rub belly in circles)

Head, Shoulder's, Knees and Toes
