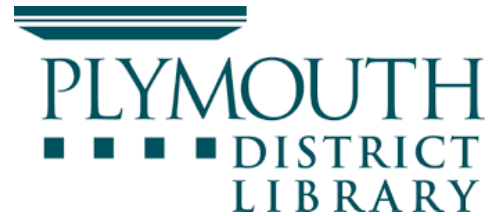

Extension Activities:
