

CONSTELLATION LUMINARY

- Cut out the box.
- Fold along each line.
- Stack the box together, you can use some glue or tape if you like.
- With a thick needle, prick holes into where stars are illustrated. You can make smaller and bigger holes to show what stars shine more brightly. Be careful! Ask a parent for help.

ACTIVITIES!

- Keep a star gazing journal. Write down which constellations you could find and what the date is. You can even draw a picture!
