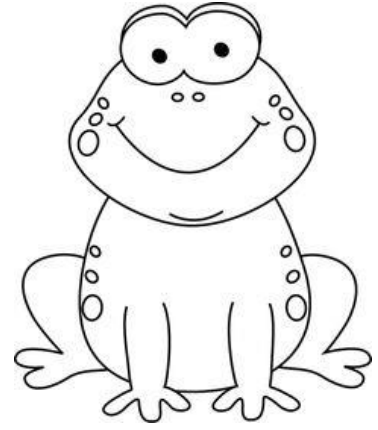

Fingerplay: Open, shut them

One peeped in and DOWN he fell!

Froggies jumped high, froggies jumped low (hold baby up, then down)

Froggies jumped everywhere to and fro.

(Four little froggies...)

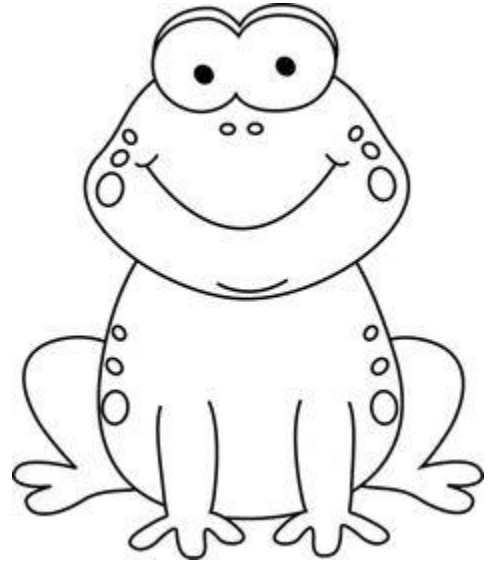
Action Rhyme: Froggy, Froggy
