

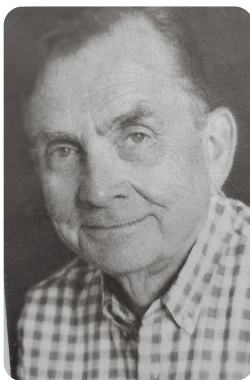
Info Session Meetings
