Extension Activities:

1. Try a fun drawing game--fold a piece of paper into three even parts. Player 1 draws a head, extending the lines just past the fold. Player 2 draws a body, matching up with the lines left by Player 1 and extending the body lines just past next fold. Player 3 (or Player 1) draws legs, matching up with the lines left by Player 2. You can draw any kind of person or animal parts you want. See what kind of hybrid animal you can come up, then give it a name like the ones in the story!

4. You may not be president, but you can be in charge while playing Simon Says! Take turns being Simon. For younger kids, Follow the Leader may work better for the same concept--imitate the physical movements of the leader as you move around the room. Take turns being at the front of the line.
5. Discuss--Have you ever been jealous of something somebody else could do that you couldn't? What's something you are good at that not everybody is good at? Have you ever teamed up with someone else to do something hard that neither of you could have done on your own?
